

Three-day technician training programme ends

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KANPUR: A three-day technician training programme for local youths concluded at IIT Kanpur on Sunday. The programme was organised by the Central Workshop of IIT Kanpur for the students of JK Centre for Technician Training (JK-CTT), located at Kamla Nagar.

About 30 students, getting training in Mechanical Technician Trade at JK-CTT got an opportunity to learn advanced skills from the experienced staff members of the Central Workshop and the department of Mechanical Engineering of the institute.

The programme included six modules consisting of engineering drawing, fitting operation, lathe machine operation, milling machine operation and measurement of physical properties. A well coordinated hands-on training session under the supervision of RC Sharma, in-charge Central Workshop and CS Goswami, was also part of the training. The students got the opportunity to work on high-quality machines under instructions from IITK faculty members, Prof VK Jain and Prof Ramkumar.
