

**GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF FULL PAPER/ARTICLE  
FOR THE 12<sup>TH</sup> IPHS - 2006**

**MANUSCRIPT:** The manuscript, including references cited, should be typed in single spaced on A4 with 1” margin on all sides. The script should be in Times New Roman Font in 12 points.

**TITLE:** The paper title, author’s name and affiliation and complete address, Fax number and e-mail address should appear on the first page of the article. When there is more than one author, the correspondence will be sent to the first author, unless otherwise requested.

**SIZE:** The size of the article should be between 4000 – 6000 words or a maximum of 15 pages.

**TABLE:** Each table should be marked in the text in numerical order.

**ILLUSTRATION:** It should be clear, concise and good for reproduction. All illustrations are referred to as Figures.

**PHOTOGRAPH:** Photograph should be sharp for reproduction.

**METRIC SYSTEM:** The metric system should conform to the International System of Units (S.I.).

**FOOTNOTES:** Footnotes to the text should be limited as much as possible and must be numbered consecutively. The corresponding reference numbers must be clearly indicated in the text.

**REFERENCES:** These should be listed at the end of article, arranged alphabetically according to the surnames of the authors and then chronologically. Following are examples of the proper reference style of various sources:

**REFERENCES IN THE TEXT:** References citations in the text should be in parentheses and include author name(s) and year of publication. Text citations of two or more works at the time should be given in chronological order. When citing a paper written by three or more authors, write the name of the first author plus “et al.”

**Submission:**

- ✓ The full paper/article should be submitted through E-mail as an attachment in the form of *MS-Word File* only.
