Dr. T. RAVICHANDRAN is presently a Professor of English in the Department of Humanities and Social Sciences at the Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, India. He won from Pondicherry University the Gold Medal Prize for his Ph. D. work on *Fluidity of Identity in John Barth and Thomas Pynchon*. He graduated from The American College, Madurai, where he won the A. V. Tilak Prize for standing First among the M. A. candidates.

He has been presenting a number of papers in national seminars and international conferences. Notable among his presentations are the ones in Bucknell University, Pennsylvania and Florida Atlantic University, Florida, USA; Kogakuin University, Tokyo, Japan; Seoul National University, Seoul, South Korea; and Lucian Blaga University, Sibiu, Romania. He has written more than fifty research articles/book chapters, supervised ten doctoral theses, edited a special issue on *Cyberpunk Literature* for the *Creative Forum* Journal, and published a book on *Postmodern Identity*.

In his distinguished thirty years of teaching career, he has taught various courses in English Language and Literature, and for most of them, based on the course appreciations by the students, he has been receiving commendation letters from the Director of IIT Kanpur. His new courses on *Climate Fiction and Films* and *Perspectives of the Posthuman and/in the Anthropocene* are for the first time introduced in India. His NPTEL Video and Web courses on *Communication Skills* and SWAYAM-MOOC courses on *Developing Soft Skills and Personality* and *Enhancing Soft Skills and Personality*, with about a recent enrolment of 53,350, are well-acclaimed nationally and internationally.

His lock-down-knock-down live webinar series delivered through various academic institutions were immensely popular and very well-received by students and teachers from Kashmir to Kanyakumari.

He has held many administrative positions including the Vice-Chairman of Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) and Chairman, Senate Under-Graduate Committee (SUGC) at IIT Kanpur.

He is a recipient of the prestigious Fulbright-Nehru Academic and Professional Excellence Fellowship (2014-15) for his research and teaching at Duke University, North Carolina, USA. In addition, he is honoured with Champa Devi Gangwal Chair Professorship at IIT Kanpur.
